**CITY OF SISTERS
TAXI AND PUBLIC CONVEYANCE LICENSE APPLICATION**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – PLEASE REVIEW THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY

- A City Business License must be issued
- All taxis will be marked with not less than 2-1/2 inch letters stating the business or trade name
- All taxis will have meters and/or uniform rates throughout the city
- Businesses providing limousine or shuttle services are not required to have meters, but shall file a copy of their rate sheet with the City Administrator
- The identification card is not transferable and shall remain posted in a conspicuous place in the vehicle
- The Sheriff's Office will conduct a criminal background and driving record check. For this review, a complete set of fingerprints for each hand must be provided to the Sheriff's Office
- The City Administrator may deny a permit. The City Administrator's decision can be appealed to the Sisters City Council
- A permit may be suspended when there is reasonable grounds to believe a driver is incompetent or an improper person is allowed to operate a taxicab. A suspension may also be appealed to the Sisters City Council
