***Barclay/US 20 Intersection Improvements
Community Workshop
November 16, 2011, 5:30 – 7 p.m.
Sisters City Hall***

The City of Sisters along with ODOT will be holding a community workshop at City Hall to present an update on the evaluation of potential improvements for the Barclay/US 20 intersection.

Participants at the workshop will be provided with:

- An update on the feasibility study comparing the benefits and impacts of a roundabout vs a traffic signal
- An opportunity to provide feedback on the alternatives presented

Specific information to be provided on the roundabout vs signal alternatives includes:

- Introduction of roundabout and signals for intersection control
- Conceptual-level drawings showing the potential intersection footprint
- A forecast of how each alternative will operate (e.g. amount of delay, length of queues)
- A forecast of how each alternative will impact safety at the intersection
- How each alternative will serve a variety of users (motorists, pedestrians, cyclists and freight)
- Planning-level cost estimates

The Sisters City Council is interested in hearing from the community about how best to control traffic through this intersection.
