### **Get Help with Heating Bills and Weatherization**

Sisters area residents needing help with heating bills can meet with NeighborImpact staff from the *Energy Assistance*, *Energy Weatherization* and *Energy Education* programs on Friday, March 26<sup>th</sup> at Sisters City Hall, 520 E. Cascade Avenue, from 9:00 to 3:00.

The *Energy Assistance* program provides financial help for low-income households having difficulty paying their heating bills. The assistance can help with electricity, natural gas, propane, oil or wood. If you need help paying your heating bill please bring your energy bill and proof of income. Applicants will be seen on a first come first served basis.

There will also be information about the *Home Weatherization* program. This program can help make the home of low-income renters and homeowners more efficient and address health and safety issues. If your home is hard to heat, feels cold all the time or has a draft, come and talk with weatherization staff.

You can pick up some good energy efficiency tips from the *Energy Education* program.
