ORDINANCE NO. 460

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SISTERS MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10.28.030
CONCERNING USE OF BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, the City of Sisters seeks to maintain a high level of public safety on its public sidewalks; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sisters also seeks to allow opportunities for children to ride bicycles, skateboards and scooters on the sidewalks in areas of the City that do not typically have high pedestrian traffic; and,


WHEREAS, the City seeks to amend the Municipal Code to allow certain limited use of the sidewalks by bicycles, skateboards and non-motorized scooters outside of the downtown core of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Sisters ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The Sisters Municipal Code section 10.28/030 is amended as follows (new text is in **bold and underlined** and deleted text is ~~struck and italicized~~):

10.28.030 Sidewalks. **Except as otherwise provided, A a person shall not ride or operate a bicycle, scooter, or skateboard, or any motorized vehicle or transportation device upon a public sidewalk within the City. A child age 14 or under and any adults accompanying the child may ride non-motorized bicycles, scooters or skateboards on the sidewalks outside of that portion of the Downtown Commercial District consisting of the area between and including the south side of Hood Avenue to the north side of Main Avenue and between and including the west side of Pine Street to the east side of Larch Street. This code section does not apply to self-propelled or motorized devices that are medically necessary for the mobility of the person.**

PASSED by the Common Council of the City of Sisters this 11th day of June, 2015 and APPROVED by the Mayor of the City of Sisters.
