

ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SISTERS AMENDING SECTION 5.35.010 TO SECTION 5.35.140 OF THE SISTERS MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO TAXI AND PUBLIC CONVEYANCE LICENSING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the City of Sisters maintains and regulates the use of its public right-of-way for the benefit and safety of residents and visitors; and

Whereas, individuals and business entities desire to use the public rights-of-way for certain commercial purposes, including transportation services; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the updates to the taxi permit process is important for the public protection, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

The City Council adopts the provisions of Sisters Municipal Code section 5.35 as set forth (words in *italics* are added and words ~~struck through~~ are deleted).

5.35.050 Liability Insurance.

(1) The applicant for a license to operate taxicabs shall file a certificate of insurance issued by an insurance company authorized to transact business in the state of Oregon listing the City of Sisters as certificate holder with minimum of ~~\$500,000~~ *\$1,000,000* combined single limit of liability or bodily injury and property damage. The City must be given at least 30 days prior notice of cancellation of insurance.

SECTION 2:


The City Council finds that it is necessary for the protection of the safety of the residents and guests of the City of Sisters to have this ordinance take effect upon adoption and hereby declares an emergency. This ordinance, therefore, shall become effective on the date of passage.
