

## ORDINANCE NO. 412

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF SISTERS MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 8.12.054 CONCERNING NOISE

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sisters controls the level of construction/repair work noise in a manner which promotes commerce and preserves the quality of life and the environment; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sisters finds that certain revisions and amendments to the City of Sisters noise ordinance are necessary to allow for nighttime construction/repair work.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:**

#### SECTION 1:

The City Council adopts the provisions of Sisters Municipal Code section 8.12.054. as set forth (words underlined are added and words ~~struck through~~ are deleted).

8.12.054 Noise. This section is adopted pursuant to the provisions of ORS 467.100.

(2) Permits.

(a) In cases of emergency or other urgent public necessity, the ~~City-Administrator~~ Manager may issue a permit allowing activities to take place at any hour. Emergency permits may not be issued for a period exceeding three days, but may be renewed for successive periods not exceeding three days each for as long as the emergency continues.

(b) The ~~Administrator~~ City Manager may also issue a permit for a concert or similar event allowing activities such as concerts or events as permitted under the applicable provisions of this code.

(c) The ~~Administrator~~ City Manager may also issue a permit for a special event on commercial property between the hours of 7 a.m. and 10 p.m.

(d) The City Manager may issue a permit to allow construction or repair of any public improvement to occur during any hour. The City Manager shall set the duration of the permit as the City Manager deems appropriate.

~~(d e)~~ Denial of permits by the ~~Administrator~~ City Manager may be appealed to the Council within 15 days after denial. The date of a denial shall be the date a permit is orally denied or the date a written denial is made, whichever is later. The granting of a permit may be appealed at any time by a person who resides or works within 100 feet of the property wherein the noise is generated as a result of granting of the permit.

(e f) This subsection shall not apply to emergency work performed on improvements and utilities. Such activities may be conducted without restriction.
