Recycling Tips

- Glass and motor oil will continue to be recycled at Sisters Recycle Center.
- Plastic grocery bags are not recyclable at the curb. Please recycle at participating grocery stores.
- Styrofoam peanuts and rigid packing pieces are not recyclable. Please bag Styrofoam peanuts before putting them in garbage roll cart.
- Please empty and clean all recyclables before placing them in your commingle roll cart.
- It doesn't matter what number is on the plastic bottle or tub, our commingle recycling program accepts plastic bottles and tubs 6 ounces or larger.

Roll Cart Service Guide

- Place roll carts out by 7:00 am on collection day, or the night before.
- Please leave four feet of space between roll carts and away from any other obstacles.
- Please do not place bungee cords, duct tape or rocks on roll cart lids.
- Place all garbage and recycling in designated roll cart so lid closes. Garbage lids popped up more than 3 - 4 inches are considered 'overfull' and will be charged as such.
- High Country Disposal drivers work all holidays except Christmas Day and New Years Day. During these holidays, regular garbage & recycling services will be one day late for both holiday weeks.
