This matter coming on regularly for an order declaring the incorporation of the City of Sisters and it appearing that a petition was heretofore filed with the Clerk of this court, signed by more than 20% of the voters living within the area to be incorporated in the City of Sisters, and the court having found the petition regular and signed by the requisite number of electors, did heretofore order an election to be held on the 9th day of April, 1946, and that thereafter and within 15 days there was posted in three public places within the City of Sisters a notice of election as follows:

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 9th day of April, 1946, in the Sisters Grade School an election will be held to determine whether a City to be named Sisters shall be incorporated with the following described boundaries. The polls will open at 8 o'clock and close at 8 o'clock P.M. on said date.

DESCRIPTION:

Beginning at a point 30.00 feet due West from the General Land Office Section Corner common to Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, Township 15 South, Range 10 East from the Willamette Meridian.

Running North 671.00 feet
Thence East 65.00 feet
Thence North 512.35 feet
Thence East 850.00 feet
Thence South 272.35 feet
Thence East 1855.00 feet
Thence South 3551.00 feet
Thence West 2740.00 feet to the southeast

corner of the Southeast Quarters of the Northeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 15 South, Range 10 East from the Willamette Meridian.

Thence West 280.00 feet
Thence North 247.50 feet
Thence East 280.00 feet to the intersection

with the Section line between Sections 8 and 9, Township 15 South, Range 10 East from the Willamette Meridian. Thence North along said Section line for 2183.60 feet.

Thence West 396.90 feet
Thence North 208.90 feet to the intersection
with the Section line between Sections 5 and 8, Township 15 South, Range 10 East from the Willamette Meridian. Thence East along said Section line for 366.90 feet to the point of beginning.

COUNTY JUDGE

That the court made and entered an order appointing three Judges and three Clerks of said election and ordering that said election be held at the Schoolhouse at Sisters, Oregon.

That on the 9th day of April, 1946, pursuant to the aforesaid order and notice, an election was held at the time and place designated in the order and that said election was conducted fairly and in accordance with the law. That at the appointed time the polls were closed, the ballots were counted and it was ascertained that 115 votes had been cast in favor of the proposition to incorporate the City of Sisters, and 61 votes had been cast against the proposition to incorporate the City of Sisters.

That on Wednesday, the 10th day of April, 1946, returns of the aforesaid election were filed with this court and the County Court did on the 13th day of April, 1946, proceed to canvass the returns of the election and found that the majority of all the votes cast favored the proposition to incorporate the City of Sisters in Deschutes County, Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the aforesaid election was fair in all particulars and conducted according to law and that the City of Sisters is an incorporated municipality as of April 9th, 1946.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an election shall be had and held in the City of Sisters, Oregon, in the Schoolhouse, within said City on the 11th day of June, 1946, for the purpose of electing five councilmen for the City of Sisters, and that George W. Wilson, Opal Poschwatta, and Effie Patterson shall act as Judges, and James Kelly, Marion Elsie Johnson, and Helen Hanson shall act as Clerks of said election.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following notice of election shall be posted within three public places in the City of Sisters, Oregon, on or before the 1st day of May, 1946:

NOTICE OF ELECTION

On June 11, 1946, at the Schoolhouse in Sisters, Oregon, an election will be held from 8 A.M. until 8 P.M. for the purpose of electing five councilmen for the City of Sisters.

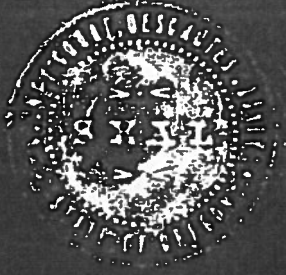

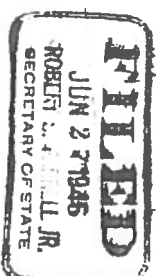
