Dear Council Members,

The buffer or 10-15' behind the south side white fence of The Pines Brooks Camp Village will be exposed once all the trees are removed.

I would like to suggest for the protection and privacy of Sunset Meadow owners and the existing Brooks Camp Village owners that the Woodhill Homes plant a row of trees along the south side of that fence. The tree that fits in that space is one recommended to me by 4 Brothers Tree Service Inc, Nick.

They grow up to 40' high and 10' in diameter. If set up with a drip system they should do quite well.

If this is not done our owners would be faced with planting trees on their side of that fence which they had to do on the east side fencing when they built the apartments behind BiMart.

This was costly and many of our owners cannot afford that expense. The HOA has not planned for that expense either.

I'm hoping you'll take this into consideration when reviewing the new plans submitted to you by Woodhill Homes.
