My husband and I will be unable to attend the November 3rd meeting on the Sunset Meadows development and would like to make our concerns known.

The Hayden Homes Development has been jaw dropping as more and more of the forest disappears. Have you ever watched "It's A Wonderful Life" with Jimmy Stewart? Think "Pottersville", that is what Sisters has become and it continues.....

We have lived here 23 years and remember when Sisters was actually a small town.
