It has come to our attention through the Nugget article that there is a proposed RV park at the site of the former historic Conklin house. My family is concerned that this proposed RV park will adversely affect traffic, increase noise, and lower the value of our homes.

We live off Camp Polk Road and are concerned about the location of this proposed RV park at Barclay and Locust. With the current redirection of traffic from the incoming roundabout on Locust, we will already have an increase in traffic of folks diverting around the center of E. Cascade Avenue.
