## CREEKSIDE CAMPGROUND RULES

## RULES

- 1. Quiet, well behaved pets are welcome. Limit two pets per site. Pets must be on a leash at all time and are only allowed to exercise in the pet run area and must be picked up after immediately. Pets are not to be left unattended at any time. Excessive barking and aggressive behavior well not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the campground. Pets are not allowed in the shower/restroom building with the exception of service animals. (Providing emotional support or deterring crime are not considered qualifying tasks).
- 2. "Quiet Time" is between the hours of 10 PM 7 AM. Loud noises (including loud voices), running generators and bright or unnecessary exterior lighting is not permitted during this time.
- 3. Only <u>small</u> fires are allowed **and only** in the fire pits (Flames can be no higher than the top of the fire ring). Campfires are never to be left unattended and must be extinguished completely upon leaving the camp site. Wood fires only. Burning garbage is not allowed.
- 4. **Campers are** not allowed to cut any trees or bushes in the park.
- 5. Lock all valuables in vehicles. The City is <u>NOT</u> responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- 6. Young children are not allowed to play on or around the bridge unattended.
- 7. All small children shall be supervised at time of high, swift water in the creek.
- 8. All campsites are limited to one additional motor vehicle per site (which cannot be RV's campers or tent trailers) and are subject to a \$5.00 charge per vehicle per night. All vehicles must display a parking permit obtained from the Camp Host.
- 9. The following Public Event Weekends require a 3 night minimum stay (must include Friday thru Sunday nights): Sisters Rodeo in June, Sisters Quilt Show in July and Sisters Folk Festival in September. Check-in is after 2 PM, Check-out is by 12 Noon. Campers staying past Noon will be required to pay for an extra night. No refunds for early check-out.
- 10. Limit one recreational vehicle and one tent per site, or one non-recreational vehicle and two tents per site. Maximum of six people per site.
- 11. Maximum stay is 14 nights in any 60 day period. Hiker/Biker maximum stay is 2 nights in any 14 day period.
- 12. Camper must occupy site on first night of reservation. Camp sites will be held until 8 AM the day after the scheduled date of arrival. If no show, the reservation will be canceled and the site will become available for new reservations. Please notify Camp Host for late arrivals.
- 13. Smoking and/or vaping is not allowed in the restrooms or showers.
- 14. No person shall use, discharge, or possess fireworks within City parks or public property unless authorized pursuant to ORS Chapter 480. No person, other than a police officer, may fire or discharge a crossbow or gun, including spring or air-actuated pellet gun or a weapon that propels a projectile by the use of gunpowder or other explosive, jet, or rocket propulsion in a public park. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to prohibit firing or discharging a weapon by any person in defense or protection of his property, person, or family.
